When Andy wasn't coaching a little league team, playing softball, or attending a Sixers game, he was dedicating his time to his family and his professional career at Batesville Casket Company.



The NPAAA Andy Kusma Scholarship fund was established in 2008 to award those athletes who demonstrate courage and sacrifice during their athletic careers. On October 10, 2009 Andy Kusma was inducted into the North Penn Sport Hall of Fame for his lifetime accomplishments in athletics.

Andy passed away December 25, 2007 after losing his battle with pancreatic cancer. He is survived by his wife, Renea, his children Shawn and Jessica, two brothers Jaak and Pete a sister Malle and his grandson Braden.
